SUPER NINE CRICKET FEDERATION OF INDIA

GENERAL PROSPECTUS 'A'

(This prospectus, whether circulated or not, will cover and be applicable to all National Cricket organized in India)

- 1. The Championship will be played under rules and regulation of the SNCFI
- 2. The matches shall be played under official draws to be taken out by the Technical Committee which shall meet minimum one day before each championship on dates to be declared in the prospectus 'B'.
- 3. The championship will be played on the dates confirmed and declared by federation under prospectus 'B'.
- 4. Unless otherwise notified, the matches shall be played on league cum knock out basis.
- 5. All such affiliated bodies who have prior cleared all their federation dues and have filled. All documents required by the federation, shall only be eligible to participate in the Championship.
- 6. Entry form duly filled up and complete in all respect must be submitted as per the Conditions printed in the form under registered cover minimum 48 hours before the start of championship. After laps of 48 hours and before laps of 24 hours before the start of championship, the same will be accepted only with the double amount of entry fees. No entry will be accepted after laps of 24 hours before the start of the Championship. As all federation records including the merit certificates are prepared according to the entry forms, the same must either be typed or legible written by hand. Illegible particulars in the entry form may be refused. No corrections in the certificates and federation records will be permissible thereafter.
- 7. Each participating official team shall consist of 9 players with 5 extra players for substitution, one coach and one team manager, thus making a total of 16 persons per team to be provided free accommodation by the host.
- 8. The D.A. will be payable by the host to the participating players of the official team along with Their coach cum manager, for the actual declared dates of the championships, as per the existing SNCFI rules.
- 9. The permissible number of players of the teams and their team managers will be issued by the Federation railway concession forms in the prescribed form for their traveling No T.A. in cash will be paid.

- 10. Free accommodation to all officials' team managers, doctors, masseurs, umpires, commentators etc. will be provided by host only for the period from one day before and one day after the Declared dates of the championships.
- 11. The host shall arrange accommodation to the coach and team managers only at the premises where accommodation for the players is arranged and the coach and team managers shall have to stay with their respective teams only.
- 12. The period for senior national championship will include days in which the umpires test, if Necessary may also be held.
- 13. All officials, umpires commentators, referees, doctors, masseurs etc. Required to attend the Championship will be paid by the host second class actual T.A. in cash on submission of approved Proper bills. The officials will also be paid D.A. by host in cash for the duration of the Championships and one day extra. The technical committee's members will be paid D.A. by the host in cash for the duration of the Championships and one day extra as actual incidental. The technical committee's members will be paid D.A. by the host in cash for additional day for arriving one day earlier.
- 14. The host, organizing committee etc .shall not be responsible for return journey arrangements of any one.
- 15. The host shall also provide T.A. and D.A. and all other permissible facilities to the required Number of umpires referees, commentators, etc. invited by the federation to attend the Championships.
- 16. The team must be in their in their distinctive color uniforms during the matches.
- 17. The team management must ring with them their two flags which should be handed over to the Organizing secretary on arrival at the venue to be collected back on return, the prescribed size of the flag is 4ft. x 3ft. No more no less.
- 18. National trophies will be awarded to the winners, Runners up and 3rd position, the same shall be allowed to be carried home only on prior deposit with the federation the prescribed amount as Caution money on refundable basis, subject to deduction for repairs and damages if any found on Return of the same. Those teams who do not desire to carry home the same must return the trophy to the federation immediately after the prize distribution ceremony is over.
- 19. The balls shall be supplied by the host/organizing committee for use during the matches.
- 20. As far as possible, the host shall try to arrange attendance of a qualified doctor with medicine during the matches.

- 21. All personal requirements as per individual taste, along with bedding kit according to the season, etc. not to be provided by the host must be bought by the teams and officials along with them.
- 22. Players seeking migration from one affiliated body / unit to another, must apply to the federation under a registered A.D. letter, so as to reach the federation office minimum 15 days prior to the actual dates of the championship. Such application must be enclosed with money order receipt covering the full migration fee and no objection certificates from both the concerned affililiated bodies / unites failing which such applications will not be considered.
- 23. The federation, the Organizing committee or the host shall not be responsible for any theft, loss or damages of any belongings of the team and officials.
- 24. The maximum age limits for eligibility in the junior and Sub-junior championship is who has not reached the age of 18 and 14 years respectively on the 31st march of the year in which such a championship is held.
- 25. The federation reserves its right to change, modify, alter, amend or cancel any fixtures at any time without prior notice or assigning any reason.
- 26. The federation office closes down for the purpose of shifting its headquarters to the venue of the championship 5 days before the start of the championship. As such, the federation will not be responsible for any correspondence received after the office is closed.
